From the Summer term 2021, it is compulsory for all primary schools in England to teach RHE. At Savile Town I & N School we have been teaching in line with the new government guidelines for some time through our Jigsaw programme of study. As a school we are working to adapt our current policy to include some new content on basic first aid and mental health and well-being.

What is a consultation period?
