This is a summary of how our school delivers music education to all our pupils across three areas – curriculum music, co-curricular provision and musical experiences – and what changes we are planning in future years. This information is to help pupils and parents or carers understand what our school offers and who we work with to support our pupils' music education.

Part A: Curriculum music

This is about what we teach in lesson time, how much time is spent teaching music and any music qualifications or awards that pupils can achieve.

KS1 – (approx. 30 mins) weekly music lessons, (approx. 20 mins) singing practise, daily songs, WOW days

EYFS – (approx. 15 mins) weekly music lessons, (approx. 20 mins) Reception singing practise, daily songs, cross-curricular with other subjects

All pupils sing through whole-school ensemble teaching (Year 2, Year 1 and Reception).

Part B: Co-curricular music

This is about opportunities for pupils to sing and play music, outside of lesson time, including choirs, ensembles and bands, and how pupils can make progress in music beyond the core curriculum.

Extra-Curricular: Wider music experiences.

Attending local music events such as The Big Sing at Dewsbury Town Hall

Part C: Musical experiences

This is about all the other musical events and opportunities that we organise, such as singing in assembly, concerts and shows, and trips to professional concerts.

Regular events include: Singing practises, performing songs in Collective Worship and Celebration Assembly.

Other special performances during the year include: Harvest, Eid, Christmas, End Of Year.

For the special performances, usually one Year group is selected to act, dance, sing and accompany songs with instruments e.g. the Year 2 children perform for the End Of Year concert. The other children support the performing Year group by joining in singing the songs.

Nursery do a separate end of year performance with singing and acting.

In working with Opera North, Year 2 have been able to attend trips to see an orchestra at Dewsbury Town Hall and they brought an orchestra into school, which Year 1 and Year 2 were able to see. We hope in working with them again this year that this will bring other opportunities to see and hear live music. Reception have also enjoyed weekly signing lessons led by Opera North. A fantastic opportunity for everyone!

In the future

In 2024, we attended an Eid Sing-A-Long at our feeder Junior School, Headfield Junior School. We hope in the future that we can see more of their performances / rehearsals.
