Charging and Remission Policy



The Governing Body of Savile Town CE(C) I & N School recognises the valuable contribution that the wide range of additional activities, including trips, clubs and other experiences, can make towards pupils' education.

The Governing Body aims to promote and provide such activities both as part of a broad and balanced curriculum for the pupils of the school, and as additional optional activities.

CHARGES

The governing body reserves the right to **request** a contribution towards the cost, in the following circumstances, for activities organised by the school:

- **School Trips/Visits in School Hours**
A contribution towards the travel and other costs of approved activities which take place in school hours.
- **Activities outside School Hours**
Up to the full cost to each pupil of all approved activities taking place outside school hours.
- **SCHOOL FUND** to be collected half termly. The charge is currently 50p per child per week and is used for extra curricular activities.
- **Nursery Places** - parents if not in receipt of LA Funding are then asked to pay for each session.

GENERAL

The Governing Body may from time to time, amend the categories of activity for which a charge may be made. Nothing in this policy statement precludes the Governing Body from inviting parents to make a Voluntary Contribution towards the cost of additional activities which take place in school time. Parents may be advised that the continuance of an activity may depend upon voluntary contributions, but once it has been decided to run such an activity no qualifying child will be excluded on the grounds of voluntary contributions.

REMISSIONS

The Governing Body may wish to remit in full or in part the cost of additional activities for particular groups of parents, for example, in the case of family hardship. When arranging a chargeable activity such parents will be invited into school, in confidence, to discuss the remission of charges in full or in part. Authorisation for such remission will be made by the Head Teacher in consultation with the Chair of Governors.
