<ul> <li><u>Technology - 40-60+</u></li> <li>Completes a simple computer program.</li> <li>Interacts with age appropriate software.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li><u>Technology - ELG</u></li> <li>Children recognise that a range of technology is used at home and in school.</li> <li>They select and use technology for specific purposes.</li> <li><u>Exceeding</u></li> <li>Children find out about and use a range of technology. They select appropriate applications that support an identified need. For example, how best to make a record of special events in their lives such as a journey on a steam train.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li><u>Algorithms and programming</u></li> <li>I can create a series of instructions.</li> <li>I can plan a journey for a programmable toy.</li> <li><u>Information technology</u></li> <li>I can create digital content.</li> <li>I can store digital content.</li> <li>I can retrieve digital content.</li> <li>I can use a web site.</li> <li>I can use a camera.</li> <li>I can record sound and play back.</li> </ul> Digital literacy/ Online safety <ul> <li>I can keep personal information private.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li><u>Algorithms and programming</u></li> <li>I can use a range of instructions (e.g. directions, angles and turns)</li> <li>I can test and amend a set of instructions.</li> <li>I can find errors and amend. (debug)</li> <li>I can write a simple program and test it.</li> <li>I can predict what the simple outcome of a simple program will be (logical reasoning)</li> <li>I understand that algorithms are used on digital devices.</li> <li>I understand that programs require precise instructions.</li> <li>I can retrieve and manipulate digital content.</li> <li>I can navigate the web to complete simple searches.</li> <li><u>Digital literacy/ Online safety</u></li> <li>I use technology respectfully.</li> <li>I know where to go for help if I am concerned.</li> <li>I know how technology is used in school and outside of school.</li> </ul>

Additional online safety

- Identify what counts as personal information.
- Identify what is appropriate and inappropriate behaviour on the internet.
- Agree and follow sensible online safety rules, e.g. taking pictures, sharing information, storing passwords.
- Seek help from a trusted adult when they see something that is unexpected or worrying.
- Demonstrate how to safely open and close applications and log on and off from websites.
- Use key vocabulary to demonstrate knowledge and understanding: safe, meet, accept, reliable, tell, online, trusted, adult, information, safety, personal, key, questions, share, stranger, danger, internet.



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
