- By supporting parents/carers to access the Mental Health services that they need.

WAYS in which I work with parents and carers.

- I can provide 1:1 support for parents/carers on a short-term basis to assist them to access any extra support they need.
- I facilitate Parent/Carer and Community Workshops & Information Sessions on a range of subjects linked to supporting children and young people's Mental Health and Self Care for parents/Carers.
- Provide Parent/Carer Self Care Group Activities within a school or community setting to promote positive mental health.
