It's hard to believe we are starting the summer term already. It doesn't seem that long since we came back in September! Let's hope we have some lovely dry weather so that we can enjoy the outdoors in the next few weeks and months.

Remember we have Stay and Play sessions every Monday afternoon from 1pm until 2.30, and another drop in for families with children who have additional needs on a Wednesday afternoon from 1- 2.30pm. Everyone is welcome.

The PCSO's (Police) have asked that we remind you all that children should always have seatbelts on in the car when you are travelling, even if it is a short distance. There are so many accidents with cars that we don't want to hear of any children in our school injured.



Nursery Places

Please remember to apply for your Nursery places for September 2026 for both 2 year old and 3 Year old places. Please let your friends know as well so they can join us in school.

Application forms can be collected from Razina in the office, or just pop in with your child's birth certificate.

Free School Meals/ Free Milk

Your child may be eligible if you receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

You need to apply online with the DFE 'applying for free school meals'. If you are entitled to Free school meals, schools also receive an additional amount of money to support your child in school. This means we can have additional staff to work with the children in classes, which with the rising costs of everything in schools helps to support the current staffing levels.



Dates

The holiday dates for the year are;

Bank holiday Monday	Monday 4 th May – school closed
Polling Day	Thursday 7 th May – Nursery is closed for voting. School is still open. Kangaroos and Penguins on a trip to Canon Hall Farm.
Sports Days	Wednesday 20 th May for Lions, Kangaroos & Penguins Please note Nursery will hold their sports day later in the year.
Half term	Thursday 21st school closes and we reopen on Monday 1st June
Summer holidays	Friday 17 th July school closes.

Please note that school will be open on Thursday 7th May (Voting day) but that Nursery will be closed as the Nursery building is being used as the Polling station.
