## Free School Meal Vouchers

Your child may be eligible for Free School meals including free milk, if you are in receipt of any of the following;

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

**You need to apply online with the DFE 'applying for free school meals'.**

So far this year Kirklees Council have funded vouchers during the longer holiday periods for families for food and towards energy costs. It is worth your while just checking to see if you are eligible. School also receives additional funding for each child who is eligible. This helps provide extra staff and resources to help your children.

Please pop into the office if you need any help.
